Completion certificate (MSB-8) may waive on-road test at DPS if you are 16 yrs old or older and have an unrestricted class A, B or C license. Completion certificate may offer discount on motorcycle insurance. Offered 2 weekends a month. Strictly limited!

Basic Rider Course II: Skills Practice - NEW!

(Formerly the Experienced Rider Course)

- One-half day course
 - Use your own motorcycle and helmet
 - Qualifies graduates for insurance premium discounts with some motorcycle insurers.
- Even if you've been riding for some time, there's always something new to learn. This Skills course will help to hone your skills and fine-tune the mental skills needed for survival in traffic. Using your own motorcycle, you'll put into practice the techniques of managing traction, stopping quickly, cornering and swerving. You'll discuss with your peers how to balance the mental and physical aspects of safe riding, manage risk, increase visibility and optimize your lane position. The course also covers protective gear, rider responsibility, motorcycle inspection and care, the effects of alcohol and other drugs on riding, and includes an optional skill evaluation and knowledge test.
- Riders must already be licensed and have the Motorcycle endorsement
 - Bike must be licensed, inspected, in safe operating condition
 - Limited to 8 riders
 - Must sign up in advance, provide photocopy of drivers license, and sign waivers. Details and downloadable forms online at www.clubedtx.com/motorcycle.htm
